Central or Departmental?

- Central
 - □ Totally research administration focused
 - Broad exposure to campus wide activities
 - Indirect interaction with researchers
 - Fewer jobs
- Departmental
 - □ Focus is broader than just research administration
 - Isolated exposure within specific Department
 - Direct interaction with researchers
 - More jobs
